Role:

- Attend Anti-racism/Inclusion Committee meetings
- Once the committee is formed, the Committee Members will vote for a chairperson
- Chairperson will attend Board meetings and communicate decisions made at committee meetings as to what next steps are to be taken by Board and address any questions, comments, or concerns
- Committee members are invited to attend Board meetings however this is not a requirement of the role
