

Guidelines for the Legacy Program - BCPTA Approved Provider Status

The Credentialing Committee of The British Columbia Play Therapy Association (BCPTA) is pleased to offer Canadian Association for Play Therapy (CAPT) and Association for Play Therapy (APT) approved providers for the next 12 months (until the end of April 2024) upon submission of current approved provider status. BCPTA Approved Provider status will have to be renewed after 2 years.

After this 12-month period, when the legacy process is closed, the BCPTA will begin accepting applications for providers of continuing education workshops and courses who wish to become approved providers with the BCPTA.

Those who wish to apply through the legacy program must pay a \$15 application fee. Once your application has been processed and approved, you will be asked to pay a fee of \$150 to receive your 2-year BCPTA Approved Provider status.
